(And why aren't they old?)

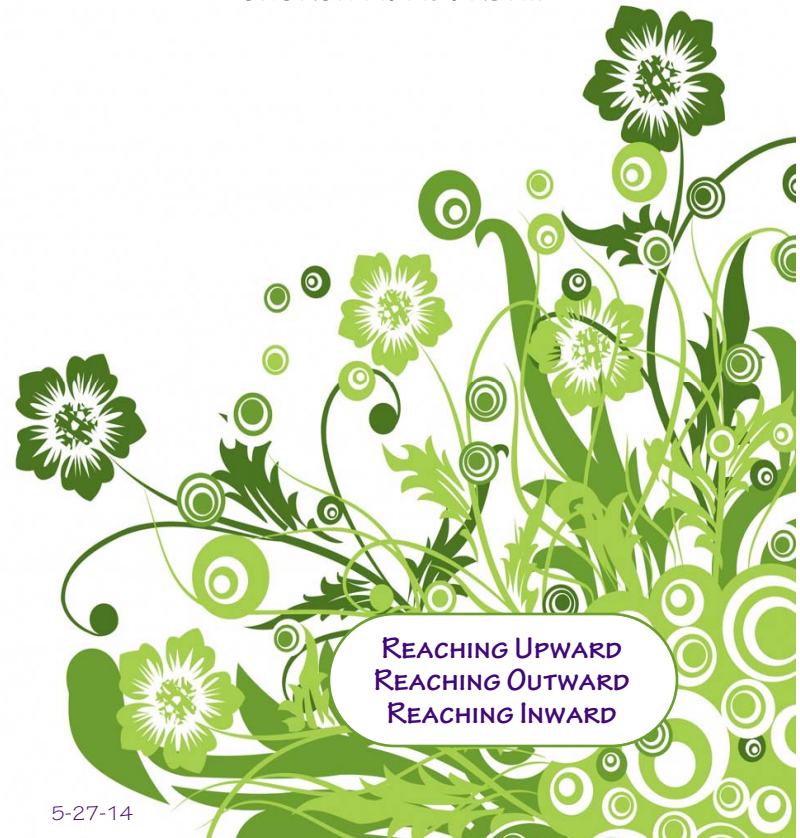

STEPS TO MEMBERSHIP

STEP ONE

Attend a “Meet MLEPC” Seminar

This is a class where prospective members gain further understanding of our family of faith and the Covenant Questions for membership.

STEP TWO

Visit with the Session

Prospective members are invited to meet with Session Elders (the member-leaders of our church) to share their testimonies of faith in Christ.

STEP THREE

Meet the Congregation

New members will attend a worship service at which time they will answer the Covenant Questions before the congregation, and the congregation will respond with a commitment to support you in your Christian journey.

Membership is extended to anyone who has accepted Jesus Christ as Savior and seeks to follow Him as Lord.

COVENANT QUESTIONS

These are the five Covenant Questions asked of Prospective members to MLEPC.

- ◆ Do you acknowledge yourselves to be sinners in the sight of God and without hope for your salvation except in His sovereign mercy?
- ◆ Do you believe in the Lord Jesus Christ as the son of God and the Savior of sinners, and do you receive and depend upon Him alone for your salvation as He is offered in the Gospel?
- ◆ Do you promise and resolve, in humble reliance upon the grace of the Holy Spirit, that you will endeavor to live as becomes the followers of Christ?
- ◆ Do you promise to serve Christ in His Church by supporting and participating with this congregation in its service of God and its ministry to others to the best of your ability?
- ◆ Do you submit yourself to the government and discipline of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church and to the spiritual oversight of this Church Session, and do you promise to promote the unity, purity and peace of the Church?

The church has three designations by which it receives believers into membership. A Letter of Transfer may be provided by the previous church for members who were active in another Presbyterian Church, a Re-affirmation of Faith may be made by those who have previously made a Christian Commitment, and a Profession of Faith may be made by new believers, with Baptism if never received before.
