(1) Time of Praise (Praising God for who He is)

Prayer for Salvation: *Open _____’s eyes and turn him/her from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that he/she may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in Jesus. From Acts 26:18*
